

2023 Tellico Trout Festival Fine Art Show

Welcome to the Tellico Plains Third Annual Trout Festival. The fine art show will be located on Scott Street. This is a juried show, all artists will need to submit 3 photos of their artwork along with their application. The theme is: ***Flora and Fauna of East Tennessee, it's Mountains and Streams as well as Trout Art.***

Two awards for artists include:

A People's Choice Award – chosen by our visitors for the best Artists Booth

Best Trout Art – chosen by our judge

The artist would submit one piece prominently featuring a Native Trout of East Tennessee

- Booth Fee is \$50.00 in advance
- Booth Space is approximately 12x12
- Artists may not change booth space without the expressed permission of the event staff
- Artist will supply all their own equipment, tents, tables
 - Tables must be covered to the ground
 - Tents must be self-supporting and include weights to prevent wind from toppling it. No spikes may be used in the asphalt to stabilize the tent.
- Artists will be allowed to drive their vehicles into the downtown area and unload starting at 6am but must immediately move vehicles. All vehicles must be out of the vendor area no later than 9:00 am
- Artists will need to be set up 1 hour before the event begins
- Artists may not break down/remove their exhibit unit 5pm on the event date without the express permission of the event staff, and such permission will not be given unless there is inclement weather or other overriding concerns. If early break down/removal is permitted, the exhibit must be removed by hand, i.e. no vehicles will be allowed to come into the downtown area.
- Artists are responsible for keeping clean and free of trash
- Personal sound systems in booths are prohibited unless all emitted sound is contained to the individual booth
- Electrical power is not available to vendor booths
- Artists can display or sell only accepted merchandise as listed on the attached application
- If an Artist violates these event Rules and regulations, they will be immediately dismissed from the event and no refund given for the booth fee
- The Town of Tellico Plains is the Event Organizer and Manager, and the Staff's decisions are final

Hold Harmless Agreement

Vendors have been advised and understands the Rules and Regulations for the Tellico Trout Festival and is bound by the terms and conditions outlined by them. Vendor is solely responsible for the quality and safety of what they sell or services they promote. Vendor shall indemnify, keep and hold harmless the Town of Tellico, City Commissioners, its employees, and all agencies the Festival has agreements with from and against any and all claims and demands, whether for injuries to persons, or loss of life, or damage to property, on or off the premises, arising out of the use or occupancy of the premises by the vendor and shall defend at the vendor's own expense any action brought against the Festival and/or any of the above-mentioned organizations or any other person or organization with which the Festival has a contractual relationship by vendor's acts or omissions.
